  - ❖ When you check "auto-renew" on your MyLegion account and add a secured credit card, you save the American Legion money by not having to mail you renewal notices.

2. **Renew as soon as you receive your first notice**
  - ❖ Postage has now gone up, even for bulk mailings!
  - ❖ Couple that with the cost of printing and envelopes, and the labor it takes to mail the renewal, and the cost is exorbitant!
  - ❖ Renew right away when you receive your notice in July...you won't receive another notice AND you'll save time and money that can be used elsewhere to help Veterans.

**We're proud to report Post 356 currently has more than 20 female Veteran members who served in the Air Force, Army, and Navy.**

- ❖ Females represent 5% of our Post Veteran membership. Although it's an astounding number for any Post, we know there are more in the Bay County area.

*When the draft ended in 1973, women represented just 2% of the enlisted forces and 8% of the officer corps. Today, those numbers are 16% and 19%, respectively, a significant increase over the past half century.*

**Help our Post percentages reach the number represented in the military today...only 57 more female Vets to hit the 17% mark.**

**We can do it!**

**Request:** When you meet a female active-duty member or Veteran, please ask her to join our Post and/or contact the Commander if you'd like to be more involved.

## American Legion License Plate

The American Legion, Department of Florida **specialty license plate** was enacted on July 1, 2013. **Anyone can purchase** the license plate from their **local tag office** for a **\$25 annual fee** (plus registration fees).

When visiting your local Tax Collector's office: Give the clerk your name, driver license number and license plate number you want to replace with the American Legion license plate.



All revenue from the purchase of this specialty plate goes towards the programs of Department of Florida. Please support your Florida Veterans, families and communities with your purchase of this specialty license plate.

### House Committee Reminders

- ❖ When a Hurricane or severe Tropical Storm is announced locally, it is at the barkeep's discretion to stop serving and close the business within 15 minutes to ensure the safety of our members and the building.
- ❖ No alcoholic beverages that haven't been purchased at the Post canteen can be consumed on our property per House Rule II.3 in order to avoid potential liability.
- ❖ Only Post/Legion members may personally purchase alcoholic beverages or pull tabs. A Member MUST pay the barkeep for alcohol for their Guest.
- ❖ Poker players: non-eligible guests may play at any time; eligible players must join a Family after three times.

Two notes of interest coming in November. Neither is good news...but are both necessary for our Post's financial health.

- ❖ **The first note of bad news is losing two bartenders:** Norma and Chrissie are moving on. Norma has been with us for years but both of these ladies will be sorely missed. Their last days will be in late October. Best of luck, fair winds, and following seas to both. There will be two new employees joining us in November....please welcome them to our family.
- ❖ **The second piece of bad news concerns bar prices.** As most of you know, our Post has not raised our bar prices in years. However, the current economic trends, cost of labor, rising product costs, and lack of supply have finally caught up to us. Face it gang...everything costs more today. Currently the House Committee is performing a line- item by line-item cost/price analysis of our beverages and other bar related items. Findings of recommended price increases will be presented, approved and announced in the near future.

- Actions that result in unnecessary costs, e.g. over pouring, damage to the property, etc.

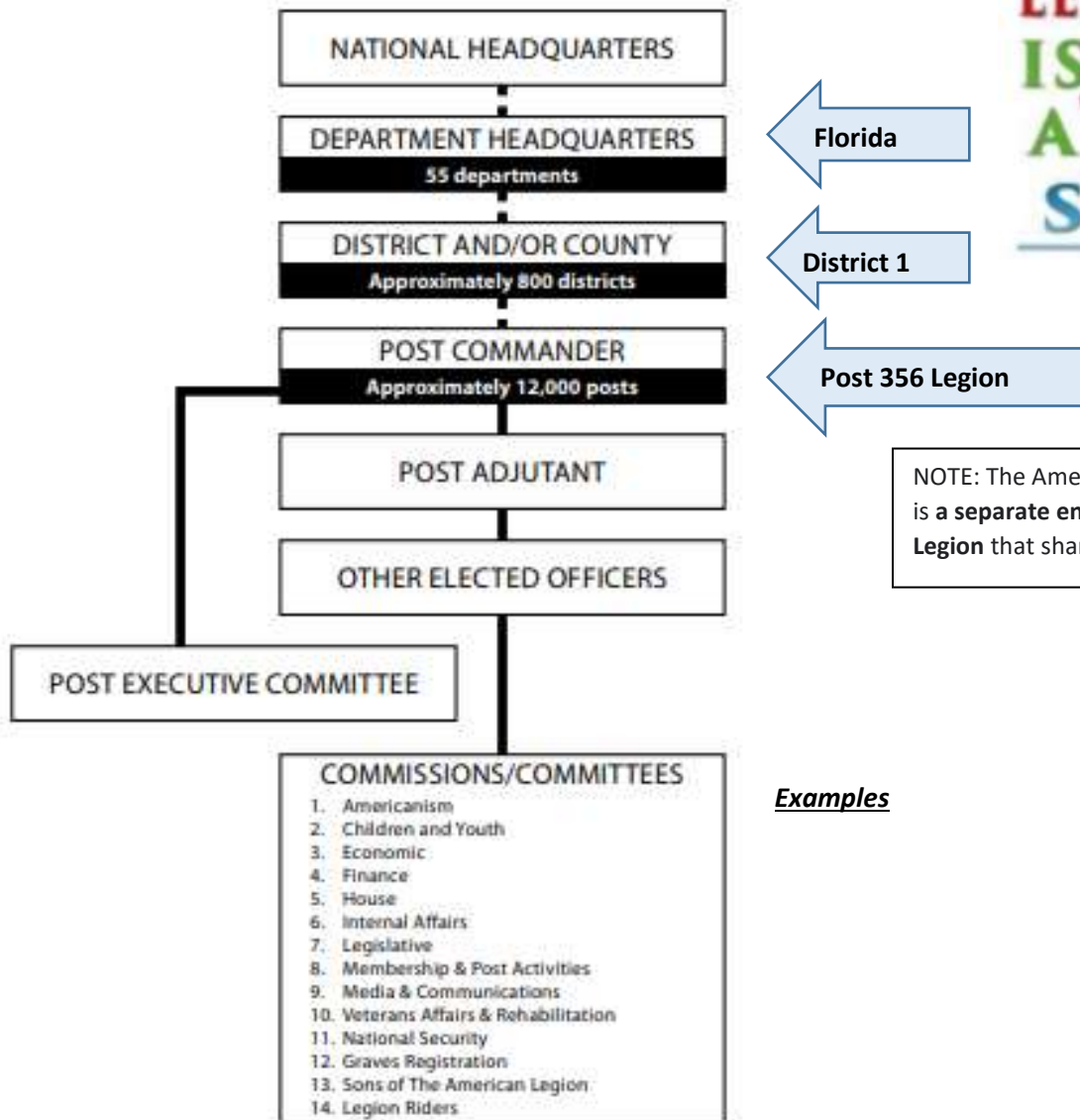

## Eligibility

Membership in the Legion was originally restricted to U.S. soldiers, sailors, and Marines who served honorably between April 6, 1917, and November 11, 1918. Eligibility has since been expanded to include military personnel who served on active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States, or armed forces associated with the U.S., between December 7, 1941, through a date of cessation of hostilities as determined by the government of the U.S., and was an American citizen when they entered that service or continues to serve honorably. U.S. Merchant marines who served between December 7, 1941, and December 31, 1946, are also eligible.

## The Preamble to the American Legion Constitution is recited at all Legion Meeting openings.

### *Do you know what the Preamble means?*

*Though brief, each clause has a world of meaning. For the next 10 months, we'll provide Post Members the meaning to a Preamble clause.*

1. **For God and Country, We associate ourselves together for the following purposes:**
  - This is the introduction. It declares that The American Legion recognizes the influence of Almighty God in all worthwhile endeavors-and declares the allegiance of Legionnaires to both God and Nation. First things have been put first. All that follows is in conformity.
2. **To uphold and defend the Constitution of the United States of America.**
  - The Constitution of the United States is the written bulwark of our free way of life and representative government. It is our guarantee of liberty, freedom, justice and democracy. Members of The American Legion bore arms — went to wars —to defend and uphold this document of freedom.
3. **To maintain law and order; to foster and perpetuate a one hundred percent Americanism.**
  - Without law and order, liberty would become license. Law and order protect our pursuit of happiness, one of our God-given rights. Members of The American Legion served in wars to uphold law and order among nations. It is just as important to maintain the due processes of law in our domestic affairs. It binds Legionnaires to obey the laws of the land and to support the constituted authorities in enforcing those laws. It means the citizen must never take the law into his own hands!
4. **To preserve the memories and incidents of our associations in the great wars.**
  - Service in defense of America is the greatest experience in the lifetimes of all veterans.
  - Recalling the highlights of that service means more than flashbacks to tense moments of excitement and danger in battle, the grime of muddy trenches, the perils of sub-infested oceans, the combats in the wild blue yonder.
  - It means also the un-erasable recollection of the comradeship, the bravery of pals, the teamwork, the sacrifices, the miseries and hardships of military campaigns shared in common.
  - It means the bond that binds all ex-servicemen and women together in mutual affection, respect and gratitude.
  - It also means keeping green forever the memories of the supreme sacrifices of gallant American patriots, sacrifices necessary to the winnings of wars. It means faithful annual observance of Memorial Day and Veterans Day.
5. **To inculcate a sense of individual obligation to the community, state and nation.**
6. **To combat the autocracy of both the classes and the masses.**
7. **To make right the master of might.**
8. **To promote peace and goodwill on earth.**
9. **To safe guard and transmit to posterity the principles of justice, freedom and democracy.**
10. **To consecrate and sanctify our comradeship by our devotion to mutual helpfulness.**
